Canada Northwest FASD Partnership This national conference is an unparalleled opportunity to bring together researchers, front line service providers, policy makers, healthcare professionals, knowledge brokers, caregivers, and individuals with fetal alcohol spectrum disorder (FASD).

This three-day conference will be held October 21-23, 2025, in Toronto, Ontario. It will bring approximately 600 delegates together to discuss the complexities of FASD and share opportunities for solutions. The Canada FASD Conference will be the first national FASD conference ever held in Toronto.

FASD is Canada's leading known neurodevelopmental disability. Its complexity requires interdisciplinary connection, as FASD intersects with fields like justice, education, social services, health care, psychology, homelessness, substance use, mental wellness, child welfare, and more. This event will bring together researchers, professionals, and those with living experience in these areas.

A FEW FACTS

- FASD impacts approximately 4% of Canadians.
- FASD impacts more people in Canada than Autism Spectrum Disorder, Cerebral Palsy, and Down syndrome combined.
- The social and economic cost of FASD in Canada is estimated to be \$10.5 billion annually.
- Individuals with FASD are known for having a number of different strengths, including being friendly, likeable, affectionate, determined, hard-working, forgiving, non-judgemental and caring.
- 90% of individuals with FASD also experience mental health issues.
- Individuals with FASD achieve positive outcomes if their needs and challenges are addressed early on in life and they have access to supports that carry into adulthood.


