### Family Relationships and Stability

### **Participant Snapshot**

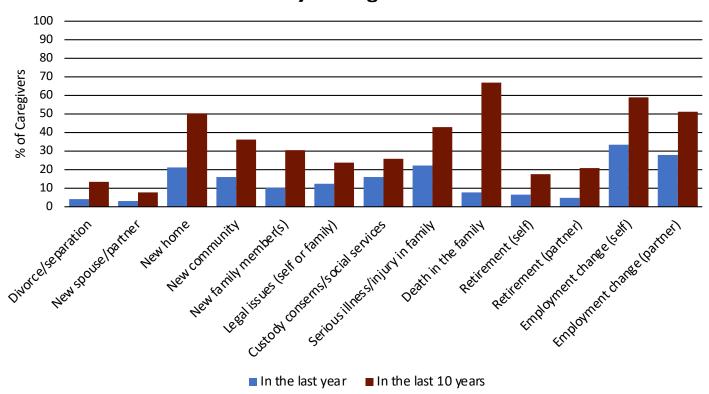
- 268 caregivers have responded to our survey as of June 2025
- Their average age is 54 years with a range of 25 to 83
- Almost all (94%) identify as women
- The majority (68%) of respondents live in Canada

has your family experienced?"

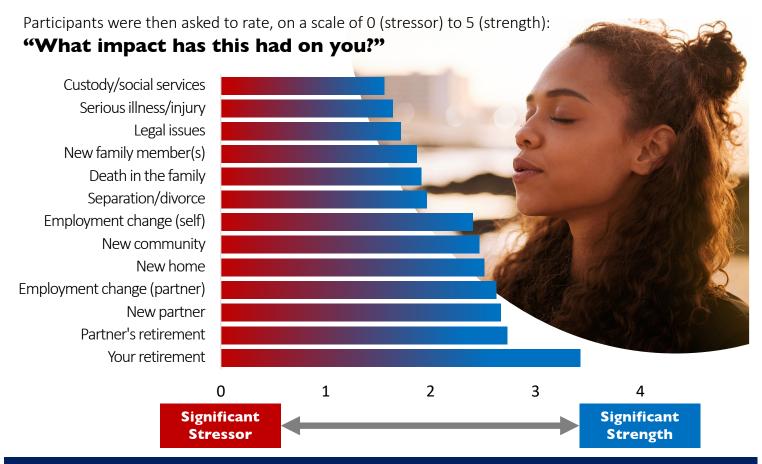
### **Family Change and Loss**



Some of the most commonly reported changes/losses reported by caregivers included employment changes for self or partner, serious illness/injury of self or family member, and moving to a new home.

# Impacts of Change and Loss on Caregivers



Caregivers struggled most with legal and social service systems interactions and illness/injury, whereas they found strength in employment changes and new partnerships.
